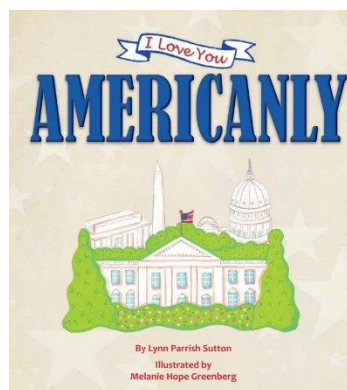

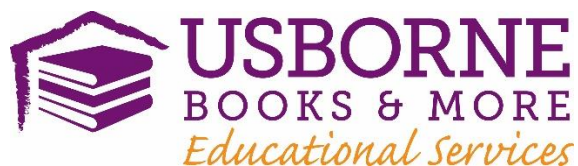
Melanie Hope Greenberg

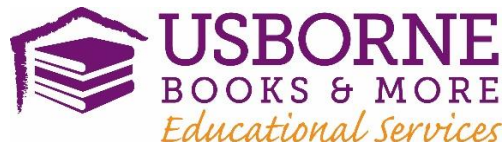
